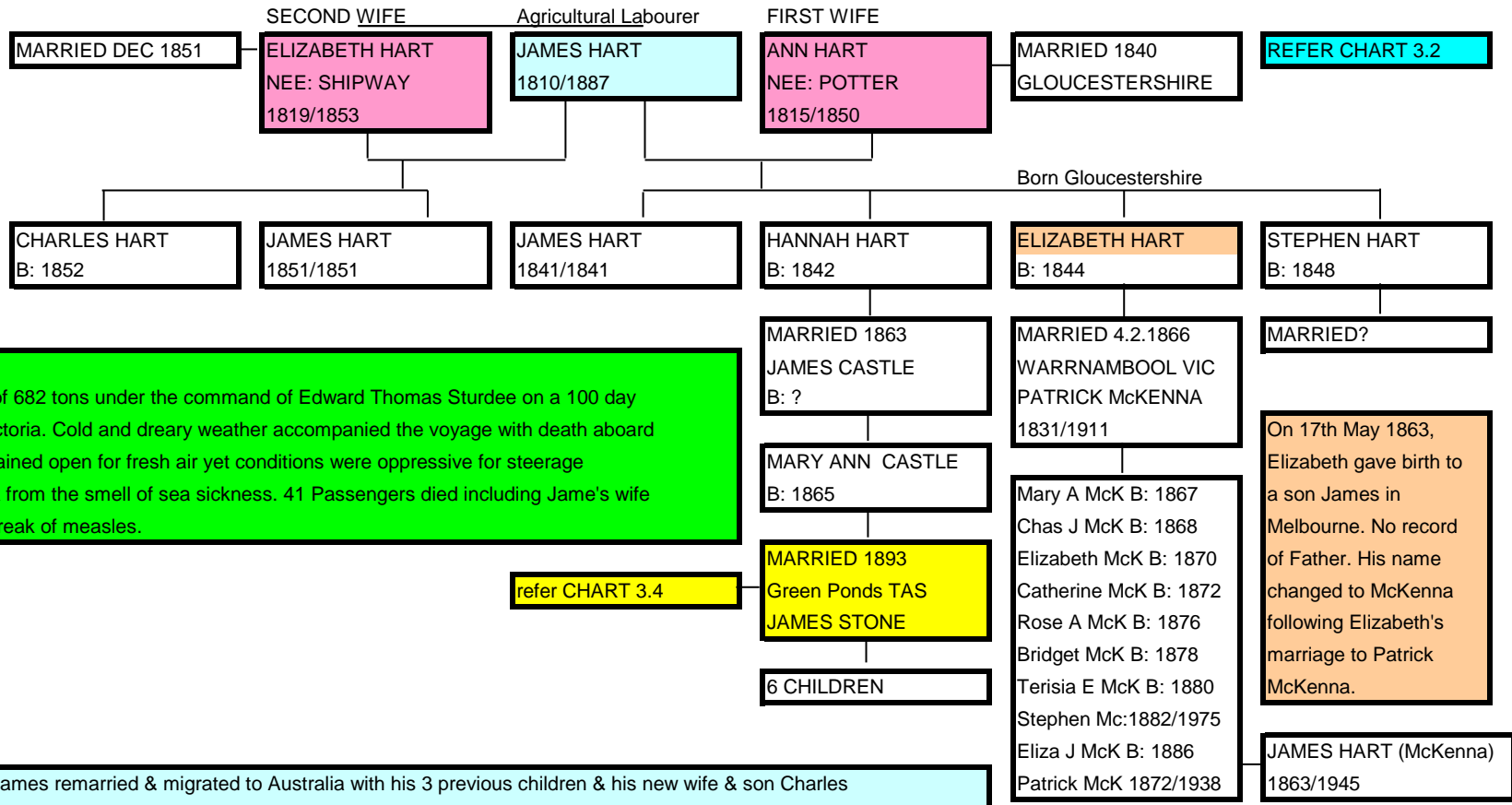

**Migrant Ship "Eliza"**  
 The "Eliza" was a barque of 682 tons under the command of Edward Thomas Sturdee on a 100 day voyage to Portland Bay Victoria. Cold and dreary weather accompanied the voyage with death aboard the ship. The hatches remained open for fresh air yet conditions were oppressive for steerage compartments which stunk from the smell of sea sickness. 41 Passengers died including Jame's wife Elizabeth. 21 from an outbreak of measles.

On 17th May 1863, Elizabeth gave birth to a son James in Melbourne. No record of Father. His name changed to McKenna following Elizabeth's marriage to Patrick McKenna.

# After his wife Ann died, James remarried & migrated to Australia with his 3 previous children & his new wife & son Charles They sailed from Plymouth 30 November 1852 and arrived at Portland, Victoria on 9 April, 1853. Ship "Eliza"

James second wife Elizabeth nee: Shipway died on 30th March 1853 from "Auasarea from Cold" just 10 days before their arrival at Portland and buried at sea.
